






Compliance Indicators

- Measure child and family outcomes
- Targets set by each state with input from stakeholders





State Identified Measurable Result (SiMR):


Pennsylvania's families and caregivers of infants, toddlers, and preschoolers with IFSP/IEPs will increase their competence and confidence to help their children learn across settings.



Measurement of the SiMR:

The total percent of families of infants, toddlers, and preschoolers participating in the Early Intervention program who strongly agree or very strongly agree with the statement "Early Intervention staff worked with my family to develop ideas and strategies to help my child learn".
