












# Strongly Agree or Agree

Actions identified to incorporate El Principles into everyday work



- Listen to families more and give them time to come up with their own strategies/priorities before jumping in.
- Really listen to the parents and what their wants and needs are based on their cultural beliefs. Sometimes this may be different than what I had in mind originally.
- Encourage caregivers to take the lead.







learning modules.














How many people have been endorsed as PA Early Intervention Coaches?












#### Six individuals being trained to coach other providers Cohort 1



















## Number of PA Early Intervention Coaches - Endorsed



as of 9/12/22












### Role of PA Early Interventions Coaches - Endorsed


