Pennsylvania families are needed to support future early childhood teachers. By sharing your experience with faculty at local colleges and universities you can have an impact! Research shows early childhood teachers benefit from hearing family perspectives on how programs such as childcare, Pre-K Counts, and Head Start partner with families. This is an opportunity to support the development of strong and effective family/professional partnerships!

Who we are looking for:

- PA family members of children (age 0-5) who are currently in childcare, Head
 Start, or Pre-K Counts. (Looking for families from all areas of PA.)
- Specifically looking for families with diverse identity experiences such as LGBTQIA+, disability, receiving Early Intervention services in inclusive settings, race, ethnicity, and multilingual backgrounds.
- No prior experience with public speaking or sharing your experiences necessary. You will have the support you need to be successful!

What you need to do to be involved:

- Complete application by November 18
- Participate in a full day virtual training on Dec. 6, 2022.
- Commit to provide 3 hours to support early childhood college students and coursework between January 2023 to May 2023.

Example activities could include: record videos of family routines and/or your family story, review course materials, participate in an interview, panel presentation, guest lecturer etc.
