



Early Intervention Service Delivery: Coaching Across Settings



PLC or Trio

Both a Professional Learning Community (PLC) and Trio Group (Trio) offer the opportunity for enhanced learning and practical application of FGRBI into everyday practice with families and caregivers. The information below shows the commonalities and differences between these two options. Ultimately, it is an individual choice and should be based upon one's preferred learning style.

Self-assessment	Self-reflection and coaching goal development through clip selection and coach feedback.	Reflections and goal setting through full session video self-assessment and individualized coaching supports.
